Recycle right

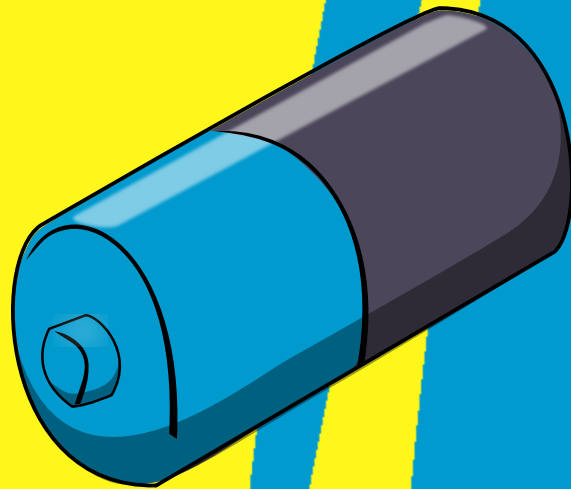
Recycle the following single-use and rechargeable batteries weighing less than 5 kilograms each:

- Alkaline
- Lithium Primary
- Lithium Ion
- Nickel Cadmium
- Small Sealed Lead Acid
- Nickel Metal Hydride
- Nickel Zinc

No wet-cell or damaged batteries please.
