



# Teacher Checklist for Success!

**SPREAD THE WORD!** The most important contributing factor to any successful recycling program is a sustained promotion and education campaign. Here are some simple ideas to keep the engagement and participation up all year long!

**SHARE THE NEWS!** Tell staff about the Challenge by emailing the Letter to Staff. Include the staff login information so that they can download the resources.

Tell parents that your school is participating in a recycling Challenge! Download the Letter to Parents to include with your next newsletter or send it home with your students. Parents can recycle batteries at work and send them to school.

**PROMOTE!** Download and hang Battery Recycling Posters in high traffic areas where staff, students and their parents are most likely to see them.

**EDUCATE!** Download and use the science mini-units developed by one of your peers and tie battery recycling into the curriculum (grades 1, 3, 5 and 6).

**STUDENT MISSIONS!** Learn about the Student Missions and encourage students to sign up! Students can win one of 10 \$50 Visa Gift Cards. Students that complete all 5 missions by Family Day will have a chance to win a family stay at Great Wolf Lodge in Niagara Falls!
