

Battery Handling & Storage Tips

- Always handle batteries with care and limit impact.
- Inspect batteries for damage. Damaged, defective or recalled (DDR) batteries pose a higher risk and need to be shipped and packaged separately.
- Identify button cells, primary lithium, lithium-ion and sealed lead acid batteries. Protect terminals from short circuiting. Tape terminal ends or individually bag cells.
- Store batteries in a cool dry place, away from excess heat and moisture. Keep away from any flammable objects or fuel sources.
