

## Damaged battery?

Identify batteries that are swollen, corroded, leaking, or have burn marks. Defective and recalled batteries require special handling.



## What kind of battery is it?

How you handle a damaged battery depends on the type. But no matter the type, always handle damaged batteries with care and wear personal protective gear.

**Damaged alkaline, nickel cadmium, lead acid, and nickel metal** batteries can be individually sealed in a plastic bag and placed into an E360S recycling container.



**Damaged lithium or lithium ion** batteries must be separated from other battery types and shipped in accordance with the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act. Carefully place these batteries individually in a sealed plastic bag and deposit them into an E360S DDR Battery Recycling Container or UN rated container packed with vermiculite or fire suppression material.
